

USD 348 FERPA OPT OUT FOR DIRECTORY INFORMATION

For purpose of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), USD 348 has designated certain information contained in education records as directory information, which may be disclosed for any purpose without your consent. You have the right to refuse to permit the designation of any or all of the below information as directory information. If a refusal is not filed, USD 348 assumes there is no objection to the release of the directory information designated.

I opt my child out of **Name Sharing**. I understand that my child's name cannot be posted on a class list, poster, sports roster, or listed as part of an honor roll or other award list.

I opt my child out of **Date and Place of Birth Sharing**. I understand my child's birthday cannot be posted in the classroom or announced over the intercom.

I opt my child out of **Participation in Officially Recognized Activities and Sports Sharing**. I understand my child's name cannot be a part of any sports roster, they cannot be recognized at any assembly or awards program that recognizes their participation in that activity or sport, and their name cannot be announced at a public presentation of their sport or activity.

I opt my child out of **Class Designations**. I understand my child's work or performance cannot be shared in a venue that would identify it as a part of a particular class. This would include things like art displays, class plays, technology competitions, debates, etc.

I opt my child out of **Photograph Sharing**. I understand my child's picture will not appear in the yearbook, on school websites, as a part of classroom decoration or designation, or on school social media accounts (note that BESPC, BESIC, and BJHS students are never identified by name on social media postings).

I opt my child out of **Weight and Height of Members of Athletic Teams Sharing**. I understand my child's weight and height cannot be listed on a team roster or shared with athletic recruiters. In addition, as some sports like wrestling are dependent on weight information it may limit my child's ability to participate in such a sport or activity.

I opt my child out of **Degrees and Awards Received Sharing**. I understand my child's name would not be called during an awards ceremony, published in any type of media report and they could not participate in the public graduation ceremony.

The following fields would typically only be shared at the High School level. If you opt out of any of the fields below, you acknowledge that you understand this information cannot be shared with any military, college, career, or athletic recruiter.

I opt my child out of **Recent Previous School Attended Sharing**.

I opt my child out of **Dates of Attendance Sharing**.

I opt my child out of **Address Sharing**.

I opt my child out of **Telephone Number Sharing**.

The opt out will remain in effect for the remainder of the school year unless revoked in writing by a parent/guardian.

USD 348 seeks to provide our students with a variety of technology tools, applications, and opportunities. You have the right to opt out of access to these tools. If you do not opt out, your child will be able to participate in all technology-related activities.

I opt my child out of having his/her work (writings, drawings, presentations, podcasts, etc.) published on a district or school-related website or social media site.

The district provides email accounts to all Baldwin High School students. Students in grades 3-8 may be provided an email account that only allows them to receive email from USD 348 teachers.

I opt my child out of having a district-provided school email account.

A teacher may record classroom audio and/or video for instructional use that would only be shared with other participants in the class.

I opt my child out of audio and/or video recordings.
