


BALDWIN CITY USD 348 PLANNING TEAM

\$25 million bond over 20 years




Improvements under the proposed bond would be focused in these 3 areas:

Educational Improvements

Cost: \$5,452,375





- New Career & Technical Education (CTE) Space
- · Flexible education space so that teachers can adapt to different learning styles
- More small group, hands-on, outdoor and personalized learning spaces



Safety & Security







- Enclosed walk-way to connect High School, Junior High & CTE facilities
- · Intermediate Center parking and traffic flow improvements for drop-off and pick-up
- Chair lift in junior high gymnasium for accessibility
- Junior High locker room improvements
- PE locker rooms connected to High School gym with exterior restrooms
- Paving and netting at the ballfields
- More parking and increased circulation at the high school and junior high






Junior High Locker Room Improvements
